Capri College High School Scholarship (Traditional)

This Capri Scholarship is for High School Seniors who will be attending classes at Capri College for the scheduled summer and fall classes immediately following high school graduation. January (or semester) graduates of high school will qualify for the Traditional Scholarship if enrolled in winter, summer or fall classes following their high school graduation within that same year. June Junior students also qualify for the Traditional Scholarship and will be required to submit their scholarship application by March 31st of their senior year in High School. All Traditional Scholarship applications must be submitted to the Admissions Department by March 31st of senior year.

Adult Career Scholarship (Non-Traditional)

This Capri Scholarship is for adult students returning to school seeking a career change. Please refer to the *italicized print* for additional instructions specific to Non-Traditional Applicants.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Submit your completed Capri College enrollment application with application fee. Submit all scholarship data in its entirety to the Admissions Office at Capri College.

- Provide a copy of your official high school transcript. For Traditional students to qualify you must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0 based on a 4.0 scale. *(If the Non-Traditional student has been out of high school for one year or more, the G.P.A. requirement of 2.0 is waived. In its place the student must present one letter of reference from employers, unrelated to her or him, who can testify to the good attendance and work qualities of the applicant.)*
- Please send two letters of recommendation directly to the Capri College Scholarship Committee. One letter from an employer, counselor, or teacher. One letter from a professional in the field to which you are applying. Do not use immediate family as references. *(Non-Traditional Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from an unrelated professional in the field to which the students is applying.)*
- Submit the names, addresses and telephone numbers and employment information of your references used in the scholarship application. See below.
- A typed essay describing why you have chosen this industry and how you will use your talents, skills and values to be an effective leader during your training at Capri College and in your future career.
- List participation in activities in your school, community, or church. Include volunteer activities in which you currently participate. This may be submitted in resume form.
- A Statement of how specific classes, extra curricular activities, community / volunteer involvement, and your own life experiences have prepared you for this career.
